In the US 9.9m people were affected in 2008, a rise of 22 per cent from 2007. In the UK, fraud and identity fraud grew 16% in 2008. Identity fraud is a growing challenge as individuals and businesses don't understand the risks nor do they appreciate how easy it is to steal someone's identity. Furthermore, individuals and businesses are not proactive to this growing crime - they only react when it has happened.

The HMRC (Revenue and Customs) data leak in the UK had a massive impact on individuals and the government in late 2007. 25m records went missing on a CD, which wasn't even encrypted - the CD is still to be discovered. Individuals are more aware of identity fraud thanks to this case - the same can also be said in the US where TKMAXX in 2007 was the subject of a major data breach involving some 46m credit card details - which in part lead to the US Congress writing a new tougher Identity Theft Bill and various new commercial identity theft protection services being setup.

How spam works

When a new e-mail arrives, it is automatically tested by a spam filter. If it's SPAM, it will be instantly moved to a SPAM folder. If you receive a SPAM mail that is not detected, click on a single button, and the spam mail is removed from the rest of the community. This is called Blacklisting.

E-mail Security

E-mail is a very important tool for the IDTP, as it works as the main tool of communicating with customers, Medias and business partners. Working in the security industry, it is vital that IDTP project a safe image. It is therefore of great importance, to be one step ahead against viruses, phishing and other malicious attacks.

For IDTP Spam filters are important as they reduce the risk of being infected with a malicious file or e-mail. It is an assurance to know that most of the spam is caught, making every day work more efficient and seamless.
